### Prakas on the Filing of the Annual Declaration of Commercial Enterprise (ADCE)

*(No. 104 MoC/SM 2008, dated 7 April 2008)*

The Ministry of Commerce (MoC) has recently issued Prakas no. 104 MoC/SM 2008, to remind all enterprises registered with the MoC to file an ADCE with the Department of Commercial Register (DCR) of the MoC.

Following the issuance of the abovementioned Prakas, Prakas no. 149 MoC/SM 2006 on the filing of the ADCE dated 5 July, 2006 shall be null and void.

Failure to comply with the ADCE lodgement requirements may result in penalties. Any enterprise that fails to submit the ADCE for three years consecutively shall be considered as an illegal enterprise.

### Notification on the New Format Incorporate Certificate and the Filing of ADCE

*(No. 0849 MoC/SM 2008, dated 8 April 2008)*

The MoC has recently issued Notification no. 0849 MoC/SM 2008 to remind all enterprises registered with the MoC to renew their Incorporate Certificate (IC) issued for over three years and file the 2007 ADCE with the DCR.

The deadline for renewing the IC and filing of the 2007 ADCE is within three months of the date of the notification.
